©Knit One Crochet too Yarn

Batiste: 50 g, 208 yds/190 m, 50% fine merino wool, 30% linen, 20% silk

MC: #251 Raspberry, 3 skeins

CC: #6520 Sprout, 1 skein

Tools:

Size 6 (4.0mm) x 40" needle or longer

Tape measure or ruler

Tapestry needle

Stitch markers

Stitch Holder (or extra piece of scrap yarn)

Removable marker

Pattern Notes

This is a top down triangular shawl beginning with a garter tab cast on. To achieve the triangular shape, 6 sts are increased on every RS row for the top garter stitch part of the shawl to lengthen the wingspan faster in the beginning. Lace panels are worked with no increases and followed by a garter stitch strip where 4 sts are increased on each RS row. The finished edging of the shawl will have a partial lace pattern, followed by 2 garter stitch rows.

Each side is maintained with a 3 st garter row on each side of the shawl.

Stitch markers can be used to separate pattern repeats. Remember to use a different color marker to denote the 3 garter sts at the beginning and end of the shawl and either side of the center st.

Special Techniques

Carrying CC: There is no need to cut the MC or CC when working the shawl. When changing colors, drop the working yarn and bring the new yarn behind the yarn just worked and start knitting the next row. If not changing colors, bring the working yarn under and then over the non-working yarn to catch it and begin working the next row.

Chart Reading

Because the piece is knitted flat, remember that RS rows are the **odd** numbered rows and are worked from right to left while the WS rows are the **even** numbered rows and are worked left to right. Chart below written directions.

SHAWL PATTERN

Garter Tab Cast On

Using MC, provisionally cast on, cast on 3 sts.

Knit 7 rows.

Turn the work 90 degrees so that the edge of the garter strip is on top. Pick up and knit 1 st in each of the 3

purl bumps. Rotate 90 degrees again, unzip the provisional cast on and place the stitches on the LH needle. Knit these stitches. (9 sts)

Set-up row (WS): K3, pm, k1, pm, k1, pm, k1, pm, k3.

Place a removable marker to mark the RS of the shawl.

Row 1 MC (RS): K3, slm, kf&b, yo, slm, k1, slm, yo kf&b, slm, k3. (13 sts)

Row 2 MC: Knit.

Row 3 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, yo, k1, slm, k1, slm, k1, yo, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (19 sts)

Row 4 CC: Knit.

Row 5 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k2, yo, k2, slm, k1, slm, k2, yo, k2, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (25 sts)

Row 6 CC: Knit.

Row 7 MC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k4, yo, k3, slm, k1, slm, k3, yo, k4, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (31 sts)

Row 8 MC: Knit.

Row 9 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k6, yo, k4, slm, k1, slm, k4, yo, k6, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (37 sts)

Row 10 CC: Knit.

Row 11 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k to marker, yo, slm, k1, slm, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (43 sts)

Row 12 CC: Knit.

Row 13 MC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k to 1 st before marker, yo, k1, slm, k1, slm, k1, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (49 sts)

Row 14 MC: Knit.

Row 15 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k to 2 sts before marker, yo, k2, slm, k1, slm, k2, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (55 sts)

Row 16 CC: Knit.

Row 17 CC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k to 3 sts before marker, yo, k3, slm, k1, slm, k3, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (61 sts)

Row 18 CC: Knit.

Row 19 MC: K3, slm, kf&b twice, k to 4 sts before marker, yo, k4, slm, k1, slm, k4, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, kf&b twice, slm, k3. (67 sts)

Row 20 MC: Knit.

Continuing in set striping pattern (2 rows **MC**, 4 rows **CC**), work **rows 11-20** seven times more. (277 sts)

Cut **CC** yarn, leaving a 6-inch tail. The remaining shawl will be worked using the **MC**.

Row 91: K3, slm, kf&b, k to 1 st before last marker, kf&b, slm, k3. (279 sts)

Row 92: Knit.

Set-up rows for lace panel:

Set-up Row 93 (RS): Knit.

Set-up Row 94 (WS): K3, slm, p to last marker, slm, k3.

Lace Panel (Part I)

Begin working the Lace Panel using the chart or written directions as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K3, slm, work row 1 of Lace Chart, slm, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, slm, work row 2 of Lace Chart, slm, k3.

In set pattern, work rows 1-6 of the Lace chart or written direction **three** times. Each 13-st repeat of the chart is worked 21 times. Stitch markers in a different color may be used to separate the lace repeats.

If using markers for the Lace Panel, remove them on the last WS row.

Garter Stitch Panel (Part I)

Row 1 (RS): K3, slm, kf&b, k to 1 st before center marker, kf&b, slm, k1, slm, kf&b, k to 1 st before marker, kf&b, slm, k3. (283 sts)

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat **rows 1 and 2** five times more. (303 sts)

Lace Panel Section (Part II)

Set-up rows for Lace Panel:

Set-up row 1 (RS): K3, slm, kf&b, k to 1 st before last marker, kf&b, k3. (305 sts)

Set-up row 2 (WS): K3, slm, p to last marker, slm, k3.

Repeat **Lace Panel (Part I)**. Each 13-st repeat of the Lace chart is worked 23 times.

Garter Section (Part II)

Repeat **Garter Stitch Panel (Part I)**. (329 sts)

Final Lace Border

Set-up rows for Lace Border:

Set-up row 1 (RS): K3, slm, kf&b, k to 1 st before last marker, kf&b, k3. (331 sts)

Set-up row 2 (WS): K3, slm, p to last marker, slm, k3.

Row 1 (RS): K3, slm, work row 1 of Lace Chart, slm, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, slm, work row 2 of Lace Chart, slm, k3.

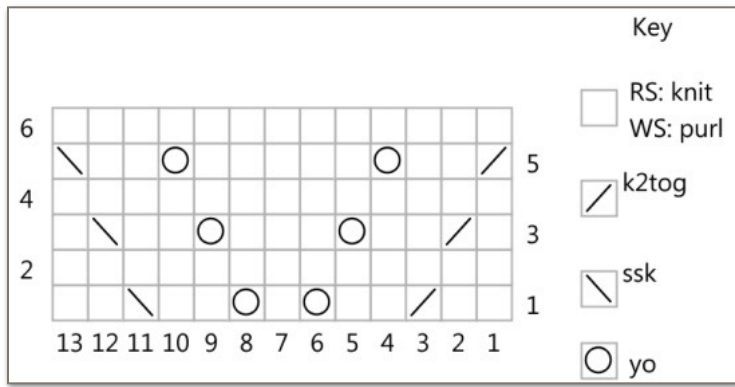
In established pattern, work rows 1-6 of Lace Chart **once**. Each 13-st repeat of the Lace Chart will be worked 25 times.

Finishing

Knit 2 rows.

Using the lace bind off, k2, insert the LH needle into the front of these 2 sts and knit together, *k1 (you will now have 2 sts on the RH needle), insert the LH needle into the front of these 2 sts and knit together; rep from * across. Cut yarn and pull through last st. Weave in ends and block to measurements.





Chart

Row 1 (RS): K2, k2tog, k2, yo, k, yo, k2, ssk, k2. (13 sts)

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: K, k2tog, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, ssk, k.

Row 5: K2tog, k2, yo, k5, yo, k2, ssk.

Abbreviations

Beg- beginning

BO- Bind Off

CO- Cast ON

Cont- continue

est- establish

Garter- Knit RS, Knit WS rows.

k- Knit

Kf&b- Knit into the front and back of stitch

K2tog- Knit 2 stitches together

LH- Left Hand

ndl- needle

p- purl

pat- pattern

pm- place marker

RH- Right Hand

rem- remain(ing)

rep- repeat(s)

rnd(s)- round(s)

RS- right side

Ssk- Slip the next 2 stitches one by one as if to knit; insert tip of left needle from left to right into the fronts of these two slipped stitches and knit them together

slm- slip marker

Sts sts- Stockinette Stitch (knit RS, purl WS)

st(s)- stitch(es)

tog- together

WS- wrong side

YO- Yarn Over



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
